Suggested Supplies

Bring PAINT, SURFACE, and BRUSHES to *every* class.

Surface Material: Hardboard / Masonite (10 pieces)

Home Depot has sheets of 24x48 at \$6, get five sheets, and have them cut in half.

Later you can work on Canvas etc. Hardboard is cheap and better for experiments.

Paint: Acrylic (various colors)

Michael's has Basics collection at \$5 a tube.

Later you can use oils, if you bring your own cleaning supplies.

Latex Flat Primer (white)

Home Depot has quart / gallon at \$9.

Use this to prep all your hardboard sheets *before* class.

Brushes: A mix from fine / wide, and also a disposable mini roller.

Home Depot has small kits at \$7, with various kinds of brushes; they also have the mini rollers.

Michael's also carries a kit, with other kinds of brushes.

Supplies for later in the class: Frog Tape, Exacto Knife, Scissors, E6000 Glue, Pencil, Plastic Bag, Water Color Paper, India Ink, and Palette Knife.
