### Suggested Supplies

Brushes: Various sizes of round, flat, filbert, bright, fan, and liner

1x 1" paintbrush

1x 3" paintbrush

Palette Knives: Various shapes and sizes

Paint:

*Highly recommended (at least 2 U.S. FL. OZ):*

Yellow ochre

Raw sienna

Cadmium red medium

Cadmium yellow medium

Cadmium orange

Green deep permanent

Burnt sienna

Ultramarine blue

Burnt umber

Titanium white

Raw umber

*Recommended (at least 2 U.S. FL. OZ):*

Deep magenta

Phthalocyanine green

Naphthol crimson

Cerulean blue

Red oxide

Dioxazine purple

Emerald green

*Feel free to bring more colors in.*

*Please avoid lowest quality paints for they don't contain sufficient pigments.*

*No black will be needed in class because you will learn how to mix dark colors!*

Other Supplies:

1x Palette

1x Sketch Book (8" x 10" minimum) Pencils and eraser

Pre-stretched canvas (student to determine dimension)

Color wheel

1x glass wide mouth jar (or big plastic ice-cream bucket)

1x rag or 1 roll of paper towel

1 roll of masking tape at least 1" thick
