## Figurative Drawing & Painting

### Suggested Supplies

4 canvases or canvas boards (medium sizes)

One newsprint pad for sketching

Charcoal or graphite pencils and a ball point pen for quick sketching

If you are using oil paints, a couple of glass jars with sealing lids for turpenoid/Gamsol and for any other medium.

Palate paper or buy a big roll of Freezer paper from the grocery store which works just as well and is cheaper!

Masking tape

One or two palette knives

Newspaper

For oil painters:

- Turpenoid or Gamsol
- Linseed oil (recommended: Refined Linseed oil by Gamblin)
- Rags or paper towel

Paints\*:

White (Flake White or Titanium White)

Cadmium Yellow Light

Cadmium Yellow Medium

Gold Ochre

Naples yellow

Transparent Earth yellow

Cadmium Red Light

Cadmium Red Medium

Alizarin Crimson

Quinacridone Magenta

Ultramarine Blue

Cobalt Blue

Prussian Blue

Olive Green

Sap Green

Burnt Sienna

Raw Umber

Paynes Gray

*\*These are just suggestions. The colors are for oil paints, though acrylics likely have comparable colors. Recommended paint brand: Gamblin; however, feel free to choose what you can afford or what you prefer. Be sure to get a large white.*

Please bring a variety of brushes, both large (house painting size) and smaller brushes. Better brushes = better paintings!
