Suggested Supplies

Scissors

Ruler

Glue Stick

Aleene's Tacky Glue-clear

Acrylic Matte Medium Gel

8x10 or larger canvas boards

Clear mailing tape

Sponge Brushes and inexpensive paint brushes

Bleeding tissue from Blick's, napkins with interesting or pretty patterns

Acrylic paints – colors optional and based on your project

Optional: Stamps and stamp pad, stencils

The following items are optional and require searching around your house, or beach:

Any and all sorts of odds and ends can be included in a mixed media project like buttons, beads, mosaic tiles, ribbons, old frames, old boxes, wooden objects, sticks, sea shells, clock parts, broken items, books, maps, toys, driftwood, cloth, images from magazines or old photos. If you bring old photos please take them to Kinko's or Staples and have them photocopied, not printed at home with an ink jet printer.
