

## Wildlife Relief

- 22x30 in. white or toned paper – 2-4 sheets ((PRO-TIP: Have all of your paper torn to the size you would like to print before class so you can spend more time making the image. REMEMBER as you size your paper for tearing to leave At Least ½ inch extra border on Each side!))
- 18-24 in. Ruler or straight edge
- Speedball cutting tool (tool w/ 5 blades can be purchased at art supply store for around \$10)
- (Up to) 12x12 in. plate 'battleship grey' linoleum
- Sketching materials including pencil and pad of paper
- Ink knife
- Hard rubber brayer
- Exacto blade or Utility knife with blades.
- Newsprint

Instructor will provide Gamblin Black, and One other tone of Oil-Based Etching Ink and Medium for the class. If a student would like to bring additional colors of Oil Based Ink., they are encouraged to do so

Students strongly encouraged to wear clothes that can get messy.
