- Integrity

- Privacy and Security
 - TAC will not give out or sell student, donor, member, or faculty information
- TAC reserves the right to refuse registration to any student if administration or faculty deem the student to be disruptive or dangerous. No guns, firearms or any type of dangerous materials may be brought into TAC.

Zero Tolerance Policy

- In order to provide students, members, visitors, and staff with a safe and supportive environment, TAC has adopted zero tolerance policy for our classroom and gallery spaces.
- This policy includes the attempted, threatened, or actual conduct done by a person that causes or is likely to cause injury to another student, member, visitor, faculty, or staff member. It includes:
 - Physical assaults
 - Threats or intimidations
 - Discriminatory behavior
 - Bullying or abuse
 - Gestures of a violent or inappropriate nature
 - Any other behavior that might reasonably give a student cause for fear or create a hostile environment.
- Acts of this nature will not be tolerated and will be responded to with the immediate removal of the person from TAC.
- TAC reserves the right to refuse registrations to any student if administration or faculty deem the student to be disruptive or dangerous.
