Call for Artwork

About the Exhibition

The Art Center Highland Park (TACHP) and The City of Highland Park join together to promote art and culture in our community through an exhibition at City Hall, located at 1707 St. Johns Ave, Highland Park, IL 60035. This opportunity is open to Illinois residents. Submissions must be original 2D works made within the last five years and must not have been previously exhibited at City Hall or TACHP. Submissions must not exceed 48" (unframed) in any direction and must be wired for hanging.

Exhibition Theme

The exhibition, *Celebrating HP150* will be held in conjunction with the commemoration of the City of Highland Park's 150th anniversary. TACHP and Highland Park City Hall invite you to submit artwork that celebrates and reflects on our community's rich history and the diverse experiences of its inhabitants. We welcome your interpretations on this theme, and what it means to celebrate community; from historical narratives, personal memories, portraits of local landscapes and figures, to speculative visions of the future that we wish to see.

The Historical Society and Architectural Society of Highland Park will be contributing archival materials to complement the exhibit. Residence in Highland Park is not a requirement to submit, but your submission should reflect a connection to the community.

Please submit 1-3 images as well as the entry form to zcarlson@theartcenterhp.org by **February 25, 2019**. Images must be high resolution JPEG files saved in the following format: Title of Work_Artist Last Name. Submissions must be hand delivered, no shipments will be accepted.

Dates and Deadlines

March 1: Artists notified by email regarding submission status.

March 6: Accepted artwork must be brought to City Hall no later than 4pm. Please bring photo ID. **Artwork must be wired for hanging.**

March 7: Installation at City Hall

March 8 – June 11: Exhibition on view

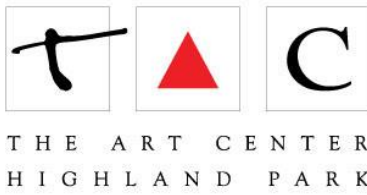
June 13: Pick up and check out artwork at City Hall no later than 4pm. Please bring photo ID.

Sales

Artwork need not be for sale, though if it is TACHP retains a 35% commission fee if it is sold during the show or as a result of the show for up to 90 days. TACHP will handle the sales process and will distribute a check to the artist within 30 days of the end of the show.
