• Paints: Acrylic Paint Sets (preferably tubes)

This list is a suggestion, but you may purchase a basic set. The four colors marked with an "X" are the basis for mixing most everything you will need.

- X Titanium white (a large tube)
- Mars black
- X Cadmium yellow
- X Cadmium red
- Cadmium Orange
- Alizarin crimson
- Phthalo green
- Green light permanent
- Deep green permanent
- o Cerulean blue
- X Cobalt Blue
- Ultramarine blue
- Deep Violet
- Dioxazine purple
- Yellow ochre
- o Burnt sienna
- Raw umber
- o Burnt umber
- \circ $\,$ Any other tubes of acrylic paint that you may already own $\,$
- Brushes
 - Small, medium and large flat brushes with largest being at least 1" wide
 - Small, medium and large round brushes
 - Small, medium angle brushes



- Miscelaneous
 - Canvas or canvas boards 16" x 20" or larger
 - knife (trowel-shaped with rounded tip)
 - Drawing pencil harder works better to sketch before you paint (something like HB, H or 2H.)
 - Kneaded eraser
 - \circ a smock or old shirt
 - A few rags or paper towels
 - Sponge
 - Small empty jars (with lids)
 - Mixing tray/palette/plate coated or ceramic
 - A paintbox or kit to hold supplies
 - Spray bottle
- Optional
 - Acrylic medium
 - Large Ziploc bag to preserve mixing tray
